DAY ONE



Downtown Walking Tour (weather permitting) - Explore 4th Street, Whiskey Row, Museum Row on Main Street and the civic district during this one-hour tour that leaves from the Louisville Visitors Center. Learn about the history of Louisville and see various points of interest, including unique architectural features throughout downtown Louisville.



Louisville Slugger Museum & Factory Tour the World- famous bat factory. Admire the world's largest baseball bat before going inside to see how Louisville Sluggers are made. Have an all-star experience by swinging a bat just like Babe Ruth's, facing down a 90 mph fastball and sharing a dugout with Mickey Mantle.



Frazier History Museum - Roam three floors of history that tell the tales of pivotal moments in history that shaped many nations. Sit back and enjoy one of the many first-person costumed historical interpretations.

Bristol Bar & Grille - Enjoy lunch at one of Louisville's original restaurants. A true local favorite, the Bristol Bar & Grille has been around for 37 year.



Muhammad Ali Center - Preserving the legacy of Louisville's most famous native son Muhammad Ali, visitors experience state of the art interactive exhibits and a biographical story line of Ali's values: respect, confidence, conviction, dedication, spirituality and giving.



Climb NULU - Go indoors and try your hand at indoor rock climbing. In this incredible, state-of-the-art climbing facility, there are is over 9,000 square feet of terrain for all climbing levels from beginner to advanced.



Wheel Fun Rentals/Segway Tours of Louisville - See the sights in a fun wheeled fashion. Explore miles of bike paths in one of the most beautiful parks in Louisville along the Ohio River. Travel across the new Big Four Pedestrian Bridge to Southern Indiana and check out the sights and offerings close just north of Louisville.

Louisville Mega Cavern - An underground adventure awaits in a 17 mile man-made cavern below the city of Louisville. One of the largest caverns in the U.S., the Mega Cavern is home to four attractions that include a tram tour, a zip line tour and a bike park.



Cardinal Hall of Fame Cafe - Home to the largest collection of Louisville Cardinal Sports Memorabilia, the Cardinal Hall of Fame Cafe is a great place to enjoy a broad menu of casual American classics for the sports fan in all of us. Come for great food, and leave with great memories!
